The nomination deadline for semester 1 and Full year is **15 April**. Nomination for semester 2 is also already possible, the deadline for nomination for semester 2 is **15 September**.

Deadline for September 2022 (semester 1 and full year)

→ **1 May 2022**

Deadline for February 2023 (semester 2)

### **Application for housing: terms and conditions**

An independent housing corporation arranges the accommodation, and the terms and conditions are rather strict. Therefore, we urge students to read the terms and conditions before applying for housing. It is possible to read the terms and conditions on

The most important matters in the terms and conditions of intermediary services for temporary housing are the following:

- The rental period is for a full semester or full academic year and cannot be shortened or cancelled once the rental period has started.
- Housing applications for SSH Reserved Accommodation 2022-2023 for UU students will **not** open until Spring. Students are asked to check regularly on [www.sshxl.nl/en/utrecht-university](http://www.sshxl.nl/en/utrecht-university) for the announcement of the exact starting date. If the housing database will be open, the student will need to register as soon as possible, because rooms are allocated on a first come first served base.

**Courses** Students are asked to choose their courses carefully by looking closely at the entry requirements. The course list for 2022/2023 will be posted online at the beginning of May (<http://www.uu.nl/en/education/exchange-students-social-and-behavioural-sciences/courses>). For now, the students can consult the current curriculum (2021/2022), but please note that this can change next year. In June (for semester 1) and November (for semester 2) the international office will take care of the final course enrolment, and students will be asked to make definite course choices.

Unfortunately, there are not many Master courses for Master exchange students available. Those students are allowed to get registered for Bachelor courses during their exchange.

**Language Requirements** Students wishing to study at Utrecht University as (Erasmus) exchange students should be able to follow lectures in English, participate in seminar discussions and understand written material. In addition, most courses require writing essays and research papers in English as well.

“We understand that an exchange study in The Netherlands is also an opportunity to improve language skills, but we kindly request a good knowledge of the English language from your students for them to successfully study at our faculty. As an indication, your students should have an **IELTS score of 6.0** (overall band, 5.5 for writing) or a **TOEFL score of 83** (internetbased test) or **Cambridge Certificate of Advanced English / Proficiency in English (minimum score C) or CEFR minimum level B2**). We would like to point out that we will be paying close attention to the language proficiency form which is part of the application package to see if the students meet this level. If your students are native speakers of English, obviously we will not need a language proficiency form.”
