	<p>study year 2022-2023 was NOK 128 887 for the whole year (10 months) or NOK 58 585 for the autumn semester (5 months) or NOK 70 302 for the spring semester (6 months) to cover your expenses as a student and to obtain a student visa (Study Permit) for students coming from outside the EU/EFTA area.</p>
