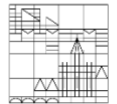

→ Yes one semester or a year

→ The normal course load is 5 courses with 15 Bilkent credits for exchange students. The students can register up to 6 courses. ECTS credits of the courses are available at course offering lists.
- *Do you have courses held in English?:*
→ The language of instructions at Bilkent is English except few courses at the Faculty of Law. International students can take few courses in the Law Faculty that are in English. We can consult this during your students' application at Bilkent University. - *Semester dates (incl. orientation, exams):*
→ The dates will be announced on the 2022-2023 Academic Calendar and we'll inform our partners about it.
- *Nomination deadline for winter (fall) and summer (spring) semester:*
→ May 15 for Fall / November 15 for Spring
- *Application deadline for winter (fall) and summer (spring) semester:*
→ May 30 for Fall / November 30 for Spring
- *Language of instruction (local/English/mix):*
→ The language of instructions at Bilkent is English except few courses at the Faculty of Law. International students can take few courses in the Law Faculty that are in English. We can consult this during your students' application at Bilkent University. - *Language proficiency requirements (local/English):*
→ We could accept English Certification Letter written by you as an Office of International Affairs University of Konstanz or IELTS – 6.5 overall, with a minimum of 5.5 on each section TOEFL iBT – 87 in total

- *Current teaching method (online/physical/blended):*
→ For the 2021-2022 Academic Year, Bilkent University administration has decided to hold all lectures, laboratories, studios, midterm and final exams, and other evaluation activities at Bilkent in a face-to-face format. Vaccine requirements are effective throughout all campus facilities, in addition to current Covid-19 measures that are already in place. Face mask use will continue to be mandatory across the whole campus including classrooms, laboratories, and studios.
- *Should the winter/fall 2022 physical exchange not be possible after all (due to suspension of in-person exchange or entry restrictions), would an (initial) virtual exchange be an option?*
→ not be possible
