

Information on data protection

In accordance with Art. 13 of the EU General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR), this privacy policy informs you about the collection, processing and use of your personal data by the University of Konstanz, Developmental Psychology, Department of Psychology, 78457 Konstanz. We also inform you about the general data subject rights to which you are entitled in connection with the collection, processing and use of your personal data in case you submit a declaration of consent under data protection law.

Collection, processing and use of your personal data

If you submit a declaration of consent under data protection law, we will collect, process and use your data exclusively for the purpose of establishing contact and planning studies at the Department of Developmental Psychology at the University of Konstanz. The data will not be passed on to third parties. By submitting your data, you do not automatically agree to participate in any study. You merely allow us to contact you and your children for the purpose of possible study participation. If you agree to participate in a study, you will receive a separate declaration of consent.

What kind of data is stored?

We only store your contact details and the data requested in the form. No other information is collected or stored. If we invite you to studies, we store the date and time of this contact. If you agree to participate and choose an appointment, we also store the date and time of your choice of appointment and participation.

Before participating in a study, you will of course be informed in detail about the study procedure and the collection of data during this study and your consent to participate in this study will be obtained separately for each study.

Data storage and deletion

The contact data transmitted by you will only be used for the stated purpose for which it was transmitted, namely for contact inquiries. They will be protected against unauthorized access and deleted when they are no longer required for the purpose of contacting you. However, you can revoke your declaration(s) of consent at any time or request the deletion of your data. To do so, send an e-mail with the subject "Delete" to entwicklungspsychologie@uni-konstanz.de. Your personal data will then be deleted immediately.

Security

The data entered in the form is encrypted (SSL-protected) and temporarily transferred to a secure web server at the University of Konstanz. The data will be deleted from this web server as soon as it has been stored by the Department of Developmental Psychology with access protection. The data is protected in every way against misuse and other impairment of the interests of the data subjects worthy of protection; it is not duplicated or analyzed in any other way.

Rights of data subjects

In order to ensure transparency in the collection, processing and use of personal data, the European Union's GDPR provides for data subjects to be informed of their rights in this context. As a data subject whose personal data is stored in the context of contacting us to participate in a study, you have the following rights, provided that no legal exceptions apply in individual cases:

Right to information (Art. 15 GDPR)

Right to rectification (Art. 16 GDPR)

Right to erasure (Art. 17 (1) GDPR)

Right to restriction of processing (Art. 18 GDPR)

Right to data portability (Art. 20 GDPR)

Withdrawal of consent (Art. 7 para. 3 GDPR)

Right to lodge a complaint with the supervisory authority (Art. 77 GDPR).
